Every season we have recruitment practices to expand our league. Officials have a single track while players have Rookie Recruitment for inexperienced skaters and Fast Track Recruitment for experienced skaters.

- Invest and participate in Orlando's local community and culture through donations, volunteering, and support

Practice Requirements

- 1. Gear. We have some loaner gear available, but we highly suggest investing in your own; gear is required for skaters (players or officials)
 - a. Quad skates (Riedell R3s, Riedell Darts)
 - b. Mouthguard- Players only (Sisu)
 - c. Knee pads, wrist guards, elbow pads (187, Triple 8)
 - d. Helmet- Must be "dual certified" (S1)
 - i. Bruised Boutique, Derby Warehouse have great "fresh meat" packages.
- 2. <u>Eligibility Form</u> completed- used to pre-assess skill level and eligibility for Fast Track or Skating Official classes
- 3. <u>Liability Waiver</u> completed- required of all league members to attend practice
- 4. WFTDA Insurance (skaters only) details on next page

Expected Expenses

- Dues are \$40 a month prorated for starting months
 - Dues can be either delivered in cash to Karma Police (treasurer), or any member of B.O.D. Must be in an envelope with your name on it.
 - Dues can be sent electronically via Zelle

 - Put your first and last name, and month paying for in the subject line.
 - For example, "Chealsea Anagnoson, August Dues"
 - Dues must be paid before you skate. If you are having financial difficulties, please reach out to the treasurer! Emails directory on the last page of this document
- WFTDA Insurance needs to be purchased by everyone on skates. Cost is \$70 per year and is valid one calendar year from purchase date; must be renewed every year.
 - Your most cost effective route is to purchase shortly before your first practice date
 - Once purchased please direct message your training lead with your name, policy number, and policy expiration date.

Recruitment Structure

Timelines differ for each recruitment class, please see the chart below for player recruitment timelines. Officials have a rolling timeline and can start at any time after the initial start date (2/11/2024). Every official will start by learning NSO positions before beginning SO training. Each individual official will graduate as assessed by Head Trainer, Head SO, and Head NSO

Once you graduate, players will be sorted and placed on a hometeam: Manatee Mayhem, Heatwave Hellcats, Snowbird Bombers. Officials will be eligible to sign up to officiate scrimmages and hometeam games.

Practice Attendance Requirements

- Attendance for players will be logged via Google Form; links will be provided in your facebook group
- Attendance for officials is not logged as you are considered volunteers for the league
- Players need to have 50% of the available practice points each month to be in good standing with the league, logging missed practices ahead of time earns practice points.

Other Requirements

As a recruit you are required to remain in good standing with the league to become a fully fledged member immediately upon graduation. Requirements for this are listed below. Once you graduate players are also required to join a service committee (i.e. games, practices, training) and complete service points as detailed in the ORD handbook- more info on this will be posted in your facebook group closer to your graduation date.

<u>Games:</u>

 Attendance at all games and completing a game day job. Each game needs all hands on deck to run smoothly, there are a variety of game day jobs (track set up, NSO, merch table, snack bar, track repair, etc.) If you cannot make a game, email games@orlandorollerderby.com

Events:

• You must make one event per quarter. Events will be posted in your Facebook group. You must sign up prior to the event and attend for a minimum of two hours to receive credit.
